The City of Napa recently conducted its annual Operating Budget Workshop, where it reviewed and discussed the Proposed Budget for Fiscal Years 2025/26 and 2026/27. The workshop focused on the city's financial outlook, proposed staffing changes, and projects aligned with City Council priorities such as climate action, road and traffic safety, parks and community spaces, housing, and community engagement. Key topics included the General Fund Baseline Budget and Measure C Fund, which support core services and council-approved projects. The proposed budget includes \$11 million in new and updated budget packages across funds, funding for new or modified city programs and services, and the addition of 10 new full-time positions and 2 new fleet vehicles. Public hearings are scheduled for June 3 and June 17 to gather community feedback before final adoption.
