First, make sure to pay a fee of \$50 before taking the test. When driving, if you get a flat tire or a tire blows out, pull over safely as soon as possible. You should also protect cyclists by signaling when exiting your vehicle on the traffic side of the road. The sign indicates that you must yield to pedestrians and other vehicles in the crosswalk. When entering an uncontrolled intersection, you must slow down and proceed if the way is clear. Before reaching the exit ramp, signal your intention to leave the highway. If there is not enough room for a U-turn, make a three-point turn instead. The sign means that you must use caution when passing other vehicles on a multilane roadway with several lanes in one direction. In Massachusetts, the posted speed limit under ideal driving conditions is 65 miles per hour. A temporary passing maneuver allows you to cross over into the opposing lane temporarily to pass a vehicle if it is safe to do so on a two-lane, two-way road. These double arrows mean that you must signal your intentions clearly and allow other drivers to pass you safely. On roadways with two or more lanes in your direction, use the right lane unless passing another vehicle. If a sign or signal requires you to stop, you must come to a complete halt.
