






Now find the GIF, video, photo, live photo or series you want to turn into iPhone live wallpaper and click on it. 3. On the next screen, customize the animated background by pinching and dragging it. 4. Then resize the timeline to include the parts you want in the animated background. You can also add filters, change speed and performance. Editing on the same screen. 5. Click the "Create" button at the top when you are done editing the iPhone animated background. 6. Click No Repeat to continue in the menu. 7. Let the app create a live wallpaper for you, then tap Save Live Photo. 8. When you get the Saved in Photos notification, exit the IntoLive app and open the Photos app. 9. From there, tap on the image and then tap on the Share Sheet button on the bottom left of the screen. 10. Scroll up and click "Use as wallpaper". Then touch and hold the screen to see the animated live wallpaper in action. 11. Finally, click on the "Set" button and select "Set Screen Lock". That's all. You finally managed to install animated live wallpapers on your iPhone. Go to your lock screen to see animated iPhone backgrounds in action.
