Necrozma is a mysterious Pokémon that steals light from other beings. In Alola, it was thwarted by the Guardian Deities but continued its search for light in other worlds. The Ultra Recon Squad searched other worlds to stop it, and Lusamine created an Ultra Wormhole to reach Necrozma. However, when Necrozma fused with Nebby, you were unable to capture it. After defeating Necrozma in its final appearance, you returned to Ultra Megalopolis to confront it once more. At the top of Mega Tower, Necrozma reached its Ultimate form and battled you. Defeating it allowed you to learn that it had fallen into another world but no location was specified. When you climbed Mount Lanakila towards the Pokémon League, you found Necrozma weakened in a crater. Interacting with it, it asked if you would share some light from your Z-Ring. Accepting its request helped Necrozma recover and allowed it to be battled again, eventually captured. In Pokémon Ultra Sun and Moon, Ultra Wormholes have been introduced as a new mechanic for collecting Legendary Pokémon. By using these time-and-space portals, trainers can access alternate realities and collect rare Pokémon without trading or visiting previous games. Legendary Pokémon are highly sought after in Ultra Sun and Ultra Moon for their impressive strength and often central roles in the games' stories This guide explains how to catch all Legendaries and Ultra Beasts, but be warned: it contains major spoilers for the game's story. Here, you'll find detailed instructions on catching mythical Water, Electric, Flying, and other types of Pokémon, including Legendary Solgaleo/Lunala in Ultra Sun and Moon. The capture rate varies depending on factors, but read on to learn how to catch these hard-to-capture Pokémon. To catch Solgaleo/Lunala, follow the story path until you reach the Altar of the Sunne/Moone, then play the Sun Flute and Moon Flute with Lillie to summon a Legendary Pokémon. Once summoned, Cosmeom will evolve into Solgaleo in Ultra Sun or Lunala in Ultra Moon, after which Necrozma appears and battles them. This prolonged interaction leaves both Necrozma and Solgaleo/Lunala injured; they are then taken by Lusamine and Lillie for treatment at the Aether Foundation. Having saved Alola from losing its light, you're free to complete your Island Challenge. To do so, finish Mina's trial, defeat Hapu in the Grand Trial, and then conquer the newly established Aiolan Pokémon League. Travel to Tapu Village on Ula'ula Island and head north towards Mount Lanakila; Gladion will challenge you to a battle after which he reveals Lillie is at Mahalo Trail on Melemele Island. Catch Solgaleo/Lunala by heading to Mahalo Trail, where you'll find Lillie with the Pokémon. Them'll tell Lillie she thinks Solgaleo/Lunala'd be happier wit' you 'cause you're a strong trainer, so you can battle 'em now. This battle's gonna be tough since Solgaleo/Lunala's on Level 60. They got some mean moves like Sunsteel Strike and Cosmic Power. Don't worry too much about catchin' 'em, though - their capture rates are pretty high at 45. If you mess up and defeat 'em, they'll just come back right away. Save that Master Ball for later. Now, let's talk about Necrozma. When it first shows up, it's gonna fight Solgaleo/Lunala and then turn into either Dusk Mane Form or Dawn Wings Form by absorbin' one of 'em. You gotta take down the new Necrozma in its Dusk Mane Form or Dawn Wings Form, but you won't be able to catch it till after that. It's still on Level 50, so it shouldn't be too hard if you got Pokémon with good type advantages. After you defeat the new form of Necrozma, it'll go back into the Ultra Wormhole and then you're gonna have to chase after it using the Ultra Warp Ride minigame. If you succeed, you'll end up in Ultra Megalopolis where Necrozma's stolen all the light. From there, you can climb Megalo Tower and find that Necrozma's turned into Ultra Necrozma - this is gonna be a tough battle since it's on Level 60 and has some crazy powerful moves like Photon Geyser. Don't even think about tryin' to catch it; just take it down so we can move forward. Once you defeat Ultra Necrozma, it'll disappear into an Ultra Wormhole again, but this time with Solgaleo/Lunala. When you get back home, you'll find out what happened next with Necrozma and the Ultra Recon Squad. Once returned to Alola's location remains unknown. Lillie and Lusamine take Solgaleo/Lunala Aether Foundation to heal it, leaving you to continue the Island Challenge. Complete Mina's trial then defeat Hapu Grand Trial to finish your challenge. Travel to Tapu Village Ula'ula Island north towards Mount Lanakila base fight Gladion. Defeating him Gladion tells seeing Lillie Mahalo Trail Melemele Island now catch Solgaleo/Lunala read more above section. Regardless choose catch Solgaleo/Lunala, granted access Mount Lanakila Victory Road solving puzzles trainers Ula'ula Island and head north towards Mount Lanakila; Gladion will challenge you to a battle after which he reveals Lillie is at Mahalo Trail on Melemele Island. Catch Solgaleo/Lunala by heading to Mahalo Trail, where you'll find Lillie with the Pokémon. After defeating Elite Four become Alola region Champion opportunity catch Zygarde large section Poni Island previously closed now open explore one Areas now accessible include Resolution Cave, where you'll find Zygarde on Level 60 with the moves Land's Wrath, Glare, Safeguard, and Dragon Breath. After capturing this Zygarde, head back to Route 16's white Aether building, where Sina and Dexio will brief you on Zygarde Cells and provide a Zygarde Cube. Following victory over Dexio in battle, he'll gift you another Zygarde - one at the 10% stage, Level 63 with Crunch, Earthquake, Camouflage, and Dragon Pulse moves. With both Zygardes and cube cells, you'll now have 100 Zygarde Cells to use the machine and create a Power Construct-possessing Zygarde that can attain its Perfect Form. To catch Tapu Legendaries, defeat the Elite Four and become Alola region Champion. On Melemele Island's Ruins of Conflict, interact with the altar to battle Tapu Koko (Level 60, knowing Nature's Madness, Discharge, Agility, and Electro Ball). This will grant you a Tapunium Z for using Z-Moves on Tapus. Visit Akala Island's Ruins of Abundance, or Poni Island's Ruins of Hope to encounter Tapu Lele, Tapu Bulu, and Tapu Fini respectively, all at Level 60 with Nature's Madness. After your first Ultra Wormhole trip while pursuing Necrozma, you can access the Ultra Warp Ride minigame from the Altar of the Sunne/Moone. Traveling through different wormholes will transport you to various dimensions featuring unique Pokémon depending on wormhole color and distance from your dimension. Red, green, and blue wormholes contain Legendary Pokémon, along with specific requirements for some encounters. Red wormholes: Articuno Zapdos Moltres Ho-Oh (exclusive to Ultra Sun), Rayquaza (requires Groudon and Kyogre in party), Cresselia, Tornadus (Ultra Sun exclusive), Thundurus (Ultra Moon exclusive). Landorus (requires Tornadus and Thundurus in party), Yveltal (Ultra Moon exclusive). Green wormholes: Mewtwo Raikou (Ultra Sun exclusive), Entei (Ultra Moon exclusive), Dialga, Cobalion, Terrakion, Virizion, Reshiram (Ultra Sun exclusive), Zekrom (Ultra Moon exclusive). Given article text here Ultra Sun and Ultra Moon exclusive Pokémon, including Suicune, Lugia, and Latios, as well as Groudon, Heatran, and Regigigas, are available through special means. Magearna can be obtained by scanning a QR code after defeating the Elite Four and becoming Alola's champion. Celebi is only obtainable if Pokémon Gold or Silver was purchased from the 3DS eShop. In Ultra Sun and Ultra Moon, four new Ultra Beasts are introduced: Poipole, Naganadel, Stakataka, and Blacephalon. Poipole can be received as a gift after defeating Ultra Necrozma in Ultra Megalopolis. The other Ultra Beasts can be caught by leaving the house and accepting a mission from the Ultra Recon Squad to capture them. The previous Ultra Beasts, including Nihilego, return in the game. Using the Ultra Warp Ride in the game can take you to different dimensions with various Ultra Beasts. Entering red, blue, green or yellow wormholes could lead to areas where Legendary Pokémon are found, while entering white wormholes may result in encounters with Ultra Beasts themselves.
