Using modern and contemporary correctly can be tricky, but understanding their meanings will help you choose the right word in your writing. contemporary times can indeed be seen as pleonastic if one considers the Latin root temp of the word time, which makes it inherently redundant when paired with 'times'. The use of "today's world" avoids this duplication, making it a more elegant alternative to "contemporary times". While some may argue that using these phrases is pedantic or overly intellectual, it is essential to acknowledge the nuances of language and avoid unnecessary repetition. Instead, opting for simpler alternatives like "today" can effectively convey the intended meaning without perpetuating pleonasm. Using technology effectively requires knowledge of how to deal with it, not just knowledge of the technology itself. The idea that "modern times demand knowledge" is often used as a cliché to emphasize the importance of adapting to new technologies. However, this phrase can be misleading, as it implies that modern times themselves are making demands. Instead, it's people who make demands and expectations through their actions and choices. When we say that "the weather demands that we wear warm clothing," we're using anthropomorphism to convey a human-like need for warmth. This is a common linguistic device used to add emphasis or poetic flair to our language. In reality, only humans can demand or require something; other living beings like plants and animals don't have the capacity for making requests or demands. However, it's natural for us to attribute human-like qualities to non-human entities, such as saying that a tree "demands" water when it withers away. This phenomenon is rooted in our desire to be poetic and expressive with language, rather than adhering strictly to grammatical correctness. By acknowledging the role of anthropomorphism in our language, we can avoid confusing the issue and use phrases like "the weather demands that we..." more thoughtfully. They don't do well on rock and pop music. I think plants and I are on the same wavelength. This is because they can demand water, which is sensitive. If you have found music that appeals to them, then you're ahead of the game. I wonder if they like your singing. Plants probably require different music genres. Times also need certain things. For instance, I'd be happier talking about plants needing water rather than demanding attention. The problem is caused by a poor choice of subject in the sentence. Give the sentence a personal subject and this wild anthropomorphising stops. Fashions are not necessarily characteristic of the present time, but the revival is something that happens and implies it is happening now. In this context, a better choice would be "current". This term refers to what is happening at this precise moment or period. It could have changed very soon, as in the case of scores in games. On the other hand, contemporary refers to things around roughly the same period in history, like contemporaries or styles from past eras.
