- **Declarative Sentence** – statement
- **Interrogative Sentence** - Question
- **Imperative Sentence** – Command and Request
- **Exclamatory Sentence**

In English, statements and declarative questions employ a different order of words and sometimes use different verbal forms. For example, the simple declarative phrase "Laura walked up to the store." To ask a question from that statement, the verb would move before the subject and change shape with the addition of a word of help, thus making it: "Laura walked until when did she go to the store?" The following exercises will give you practice in changing the order of words and (in some cases) verbal forms by converting 20 declarative sentences into interrogative sentences. Please note that these exercises are not intended to add question words to make entirely new sentences, as in "Where did Laura walk? But they must be just declarative-to-interrogation conversions. After completing this exercise, try "Practice on Declarative Sentences" Rewrite each of the following phrases as a question. When you finish, compare your new interrogative phrases with the sample responses. Note that for some of these phrases, you will have to use help words (did, do, can, etc.) to form a question, and for several of the examples, there may be more than one correct answer. Did the repairs to the car cost more than the car was worth? The sentences can be categorized into different types. At the beginning of basic education, students learn about declarative, imperative, interrogative and exclamatory phrases. Let us take you through each type and show you some examples. A declarative phrase makes a statement. They are among the most common phrases we use. They always end with a period. For example, today I had ice cream on the beach. Spider-Man's playing at the movies this weekend. Cats like to take long naps in warm and cozy places. An imperative phrase gives an order or makes a request. These phrases either end at an exclamation point or a period. For example, once dry, remove clean clothes from the drying clothesline. It's time to get up for school! Out of the pool! An interrogation phrase is the one who asks a question. For example: How much does this cost? Chocolate chip? Where are we going this weekend? When we set out to travel? An exclamatory sentence expresses strong feelings. These phrases always end up in an exclamation point. For example: Don't touch the stove! Stop talking so loud! Hurry up, hurry up! In our first year grammar section we have a number of worksheets for students to start practicing the difference between the four types of phrases. Thus, students can practice changing a sentence type to a different type of sentence or declarative conviction for an interrogative sentence. Learning the types of phrases will help students improve their writing. There are four types of phrases in the English language. They are declarative, imperative, interrogative and exclamatory. Claims make a statement. Imperative sentences give a command. Questioning phrases ask a question. Exclamatory sentences express a strong feeling.
