The number of U.S. households that were unbanked last year fell to the lowest level since 2009, in part because people opened accounts during the pandemic to get financial help, says a new report. About 4.5% of American households, or 5.9 million households, did not have a checking or savings account at a bank or credit union in 2021, according to the latest survey by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, an all-time low. Households that do not have or do not accept banking services. About 45% of households that received stimulus payments, unemployment benefits or other government assistance since the pandemic began in March 2020 said the funds helped them open an account, according to the biennial report, has been in operation since 2009. "Safe and accessible bank accounts are helping to attract more Americans to the banking system and will continue to play an important role in promoting economic inclusion for all Americans," said Acting FDIC Chairman Martin J.
